# INSTALLER AND OWNER GUIDE

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## SAFETY

**This product uses a burner and fuel effect pieces (AC models include a burner compartment rear wall) containing Refractory Ceramic Fibres (RCF), which are man-made vitreous silicate fibres. Excessive exposure to these materials may cause irritation to eyes, skin and respiratory tract. Consequently, it is important to take care when handling these articles to ensure that the release of dust is kept to a minimum. To ensure that the release of fibres from these RCF articles is kept to a minimum, during installation and servicing we recommend that you use a HEPA filtered vacuum to remove any dust and soot accumulated in and around the fire before and after working on the fire. When replacing these articles we recommend that the replaced items are not broken up, but are sealed within a heavy duty polythene bag, clearly labelled as RCF waste. RCF waste is classed as a stable, non-reactive hazardous waste and may be disposed at a landfill licenced to accept such waste. Protective clothing is not required when handling these articles, but we recommend you follow the normal hygiene rules of not smoking, eating or drinking in the work area and always wash your hands before eating or drinking.**

## FITTING THE FRONT AND REAR BASE PEBBLES

The ceramic fuel effect may cause staining / discolouration to decorative surfaces. It is therefore advisable to protect decorative surfaces.

### 1. Placing the front base pebble

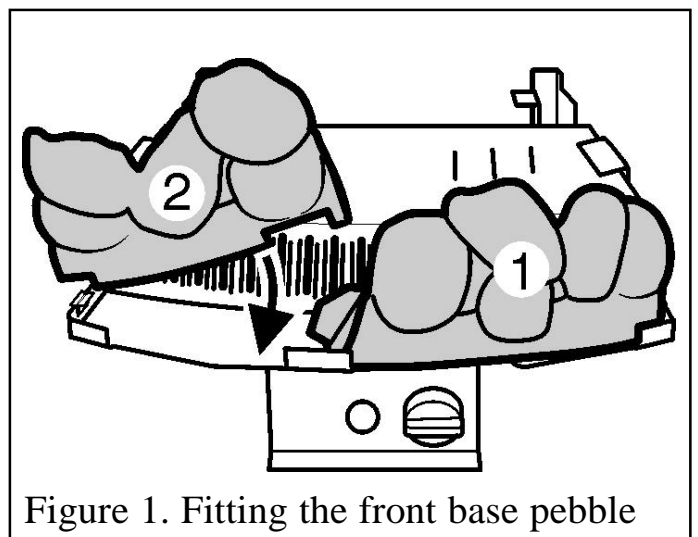


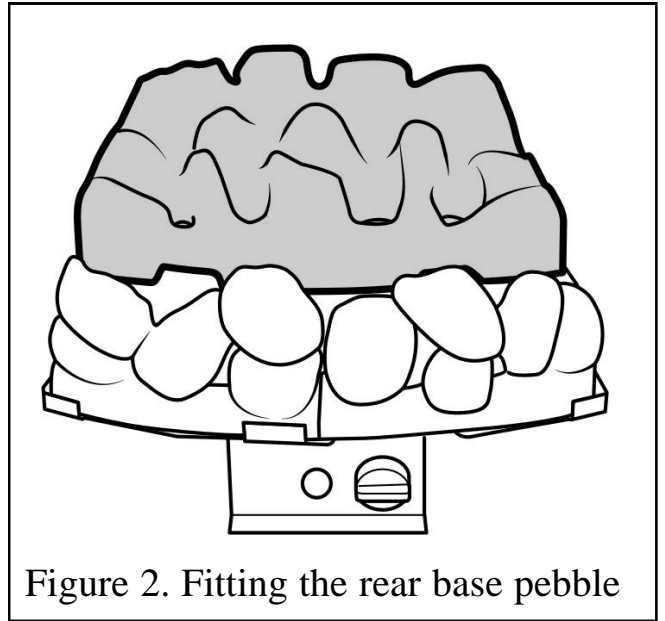
Figure 1. Fitting the front base pebble

Remove the two halves of the front base pebble from its protective packaging. The outer edges of the burner tray are fitted with clips. Do **not** remove the clips. Locate the right hand base pebble as in figure 1. Locate the left hand base pebble as in figure 1. It may be necessary to gently push the two halves apart in order to fit the left hand base

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pebble. The front base pebble should fit snugly between the burner and the two raised tabs on the front edge of the tray. When located, gently push the two halves together. This will reduce the gap in the centre.

## 2. Placing the rear base pebble

Remove the rear base pebble from its protective packaging and position on top of the burner as shown in figure 2. The rear face of the rear base pebble should locate into two cut-outs on the top face of the rear legs. Ensure that the rear base pebble sits flatly on the top of the burner.

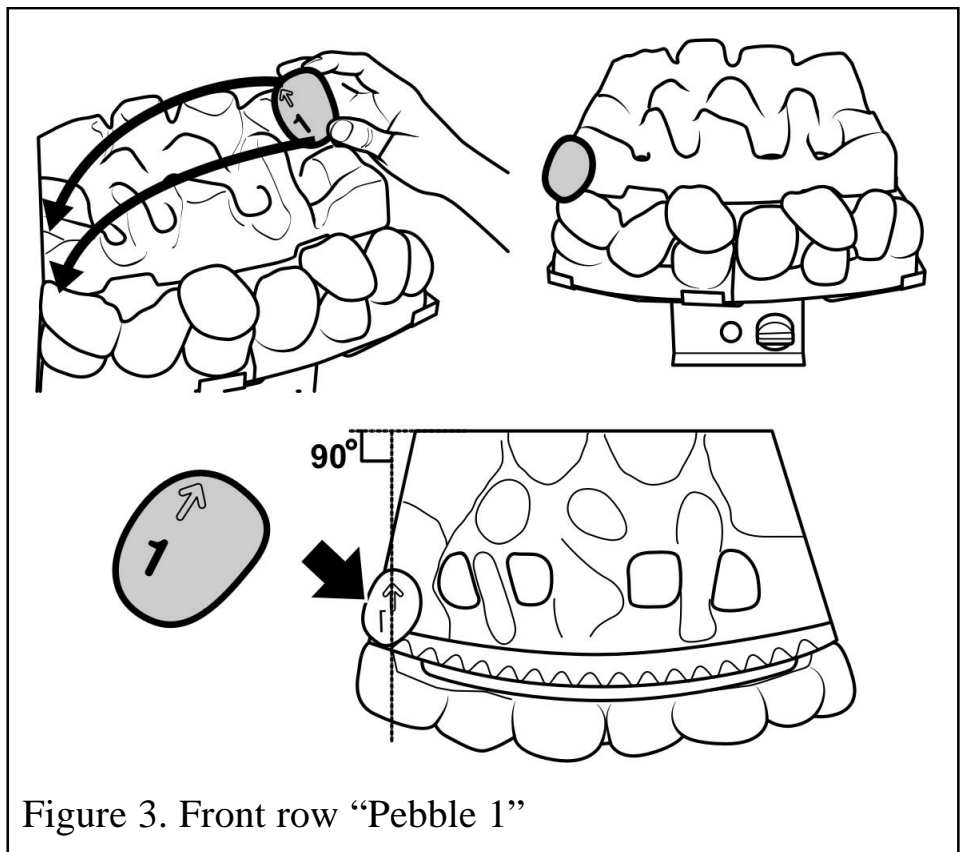


# FITTING THE DRESS PEBBLES

Open the bag containing the dress pebbles. The bag will contain 16 ceramic dress pebbles. The underside of each pebble is marked with a number '1' to '16' and an arrow. Install the 16 dress pebbles as follows:

The pebbles should be positioned so that the arrows are on the bottom and always point towards the back of the fireplace opening. When located into position the stem of each arrow should be at 90° to the rear of the fireplace opening (See figure 3).

**1.** Hold pebble '1' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '1' as shown in figure 3. It should bridge the front and rear base pebbles.

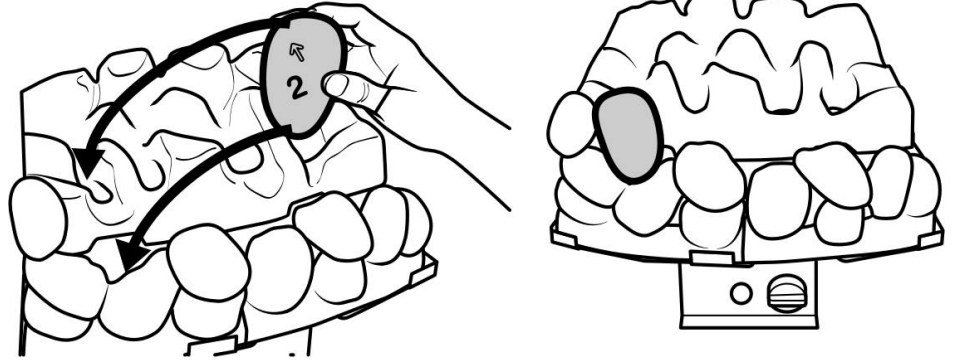


Figure 4. Front row "Pebble 2"

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2. Hold pebble '2' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '2' as shown in figure 4. It should bridge the front and rear base pebbles.

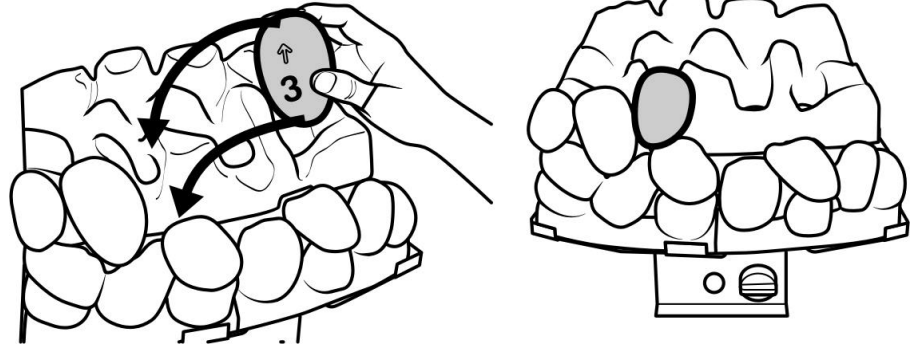


Figure 5. Front row "Pebble 3"

3. Hold pebble '3' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '3' as shown in figure 5. It should bridge the front and rear base pebbles.

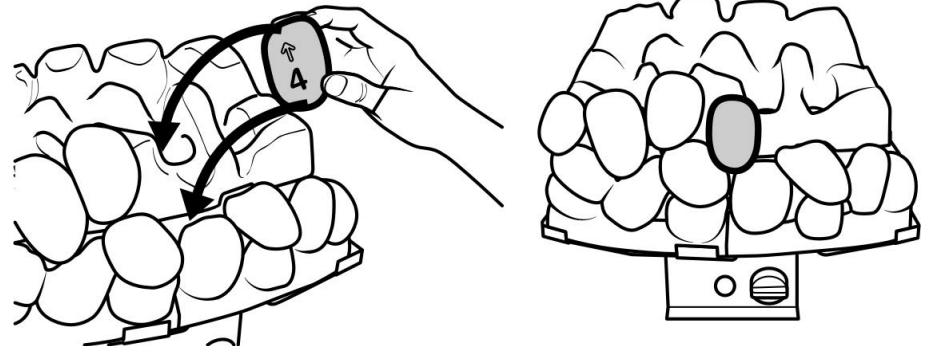


Figure 6. First row "Pebble 4"

4. Hold pebble '4' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '4' as shown in figure 6. It should bridge the front and rear base pebbles.

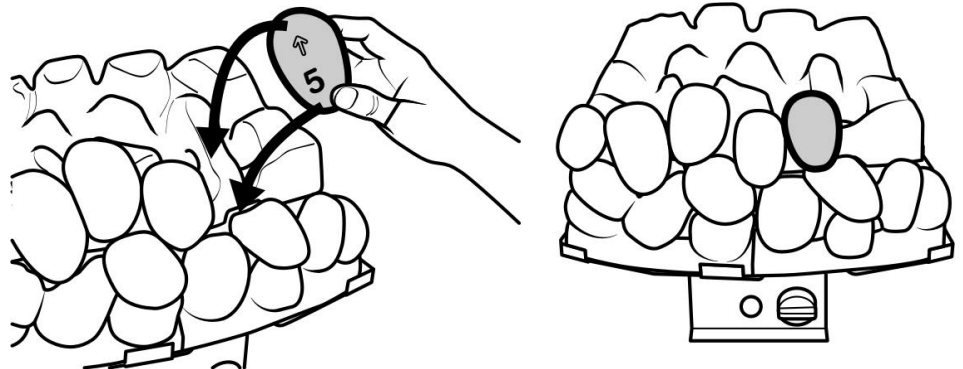


Figure 7. First row "Pebble 5"

5. Hold pebble '5' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '5' as shown in figure 7. It should bridge the front and rear base pebbles.

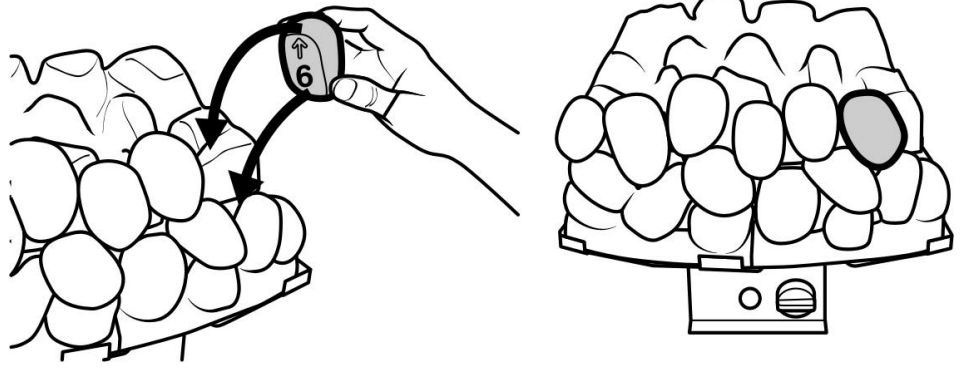


Figure 8. First row "Pebble 6"

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6. Hold pebble '6' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '6' as shown in figure 8. It should bridge the front and rear base pebbles.

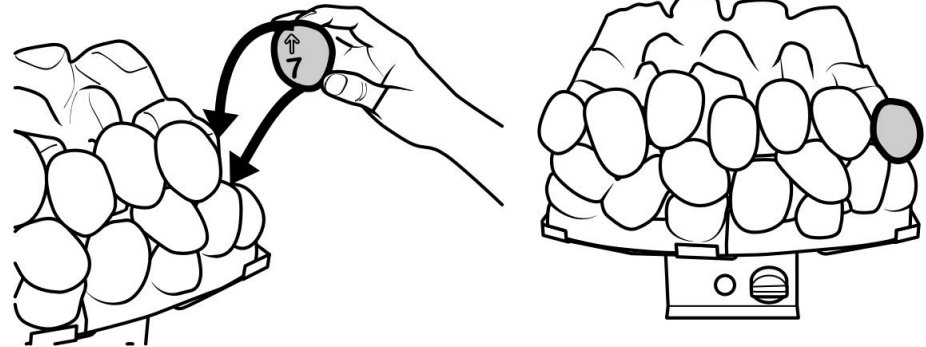


Figure 9. Front row "Pebble 7"

7. Hold pebble '7' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '7' as shown in figure 9. It should bridge the front and rear base pebbles.

This will complete the first row of pebbles.

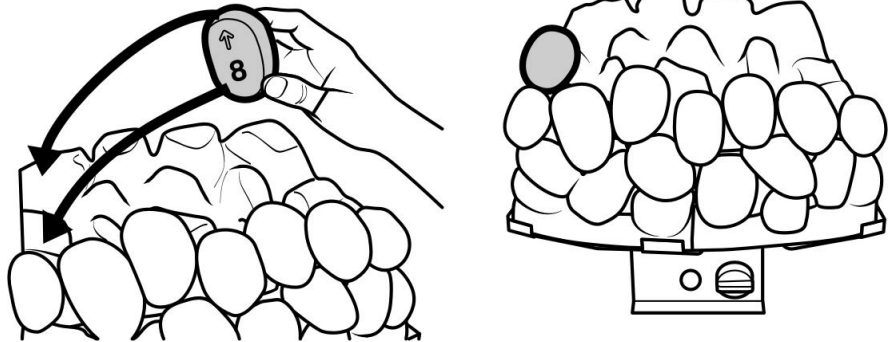


Figure 10. Second row "Pebble 8"

8. Hold pebble '8' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '8' as shown in figure 10.

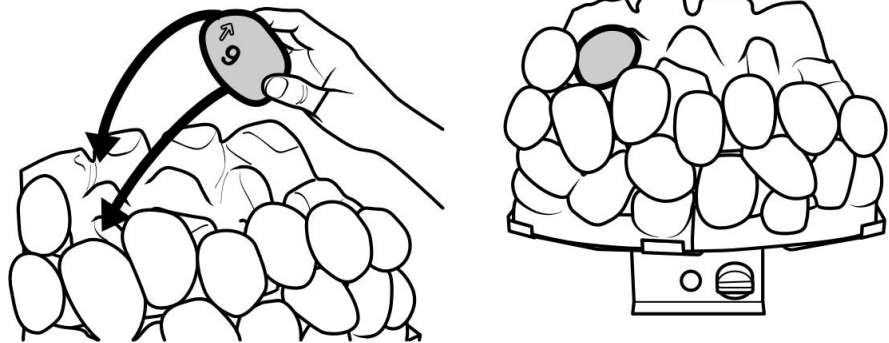


Figure 11. Second row "Pebble 9"

9. Hold pebble '9' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '9' as shown in figure 11.

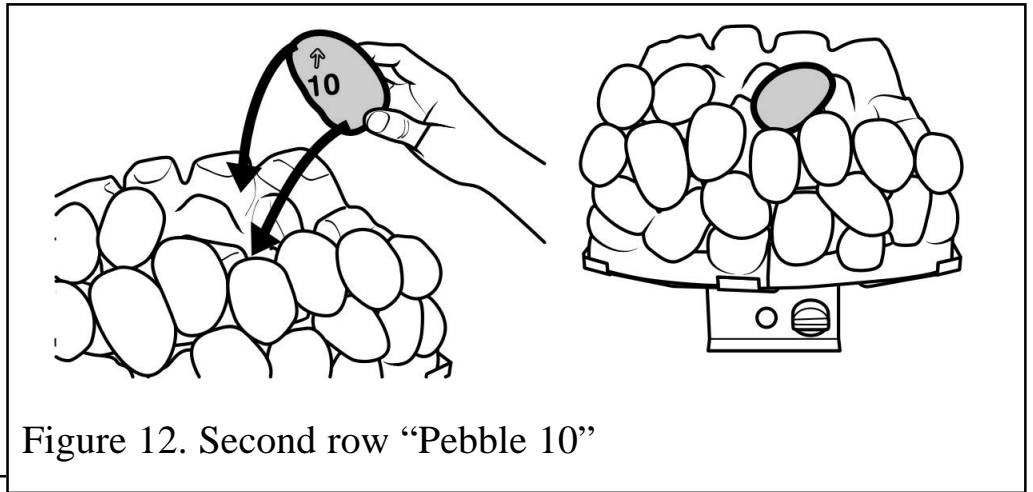


Figure 12. Second row "Pebble 10"

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**10.** Hold pebble '10' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '10' as shown in figure 12.

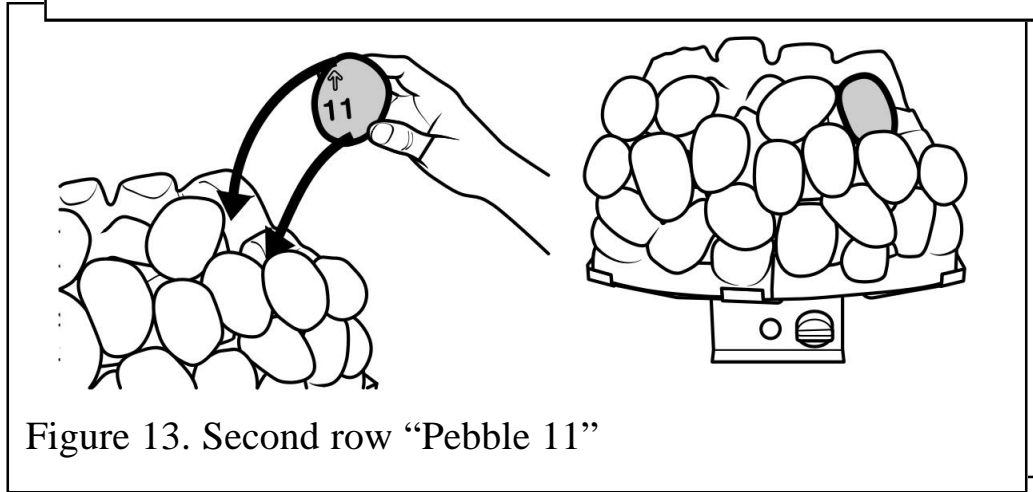


Figure 13. Second row "Pebble 11"

**11.** Hold pebble '11' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '11' as shown in figure 13.

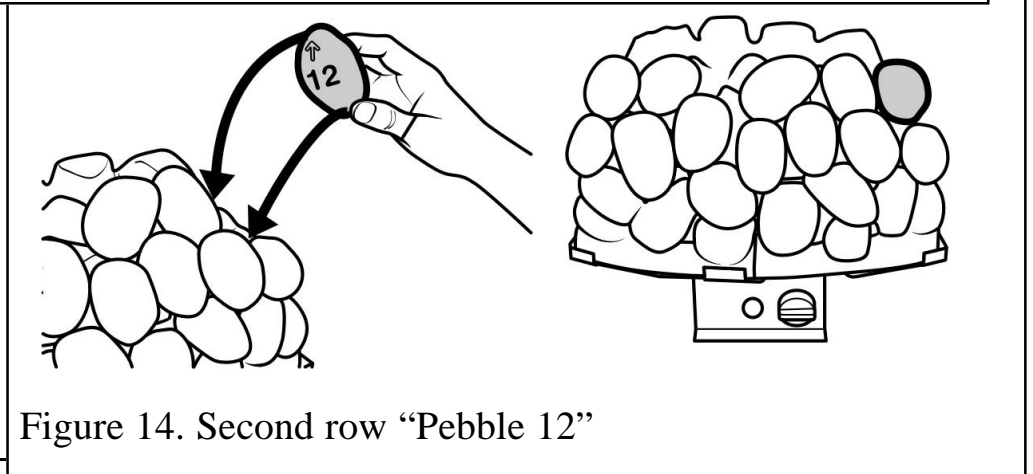


Figure 14. Second row "Pebble 12"

**12.** Hold pebble '12' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '12' as shown in figure 14.

This will complete the second row of pebbles.

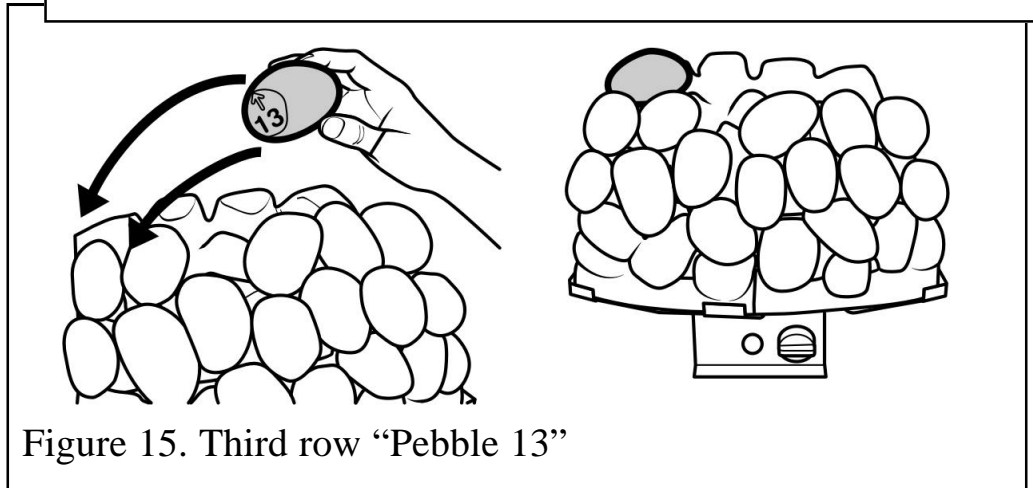


Figure 15. Third row "Pebble 13"

**13.** Hold pebble '13' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '13' as shown in figure 15.

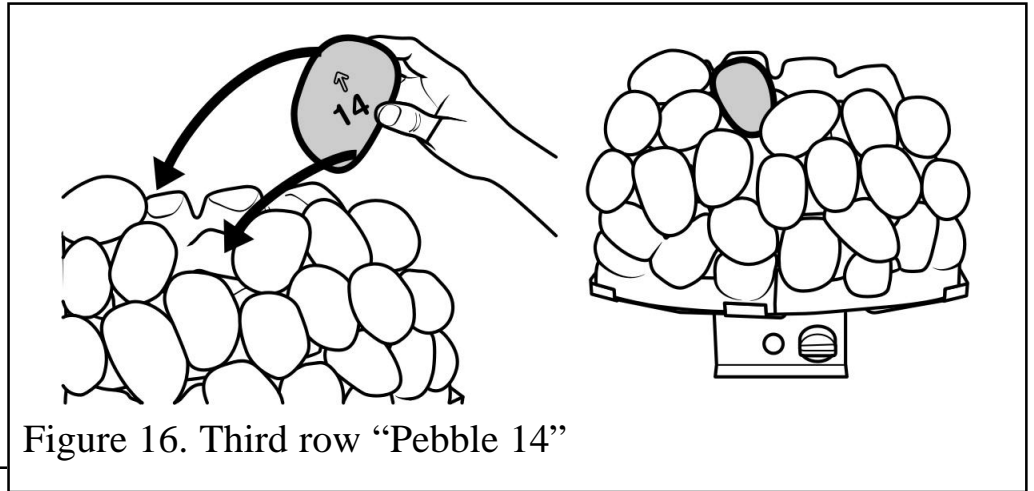


Figure 16. Third row "Pebble 14"

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**14.** Hold pebble '14' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '14' as shown in figure 16.

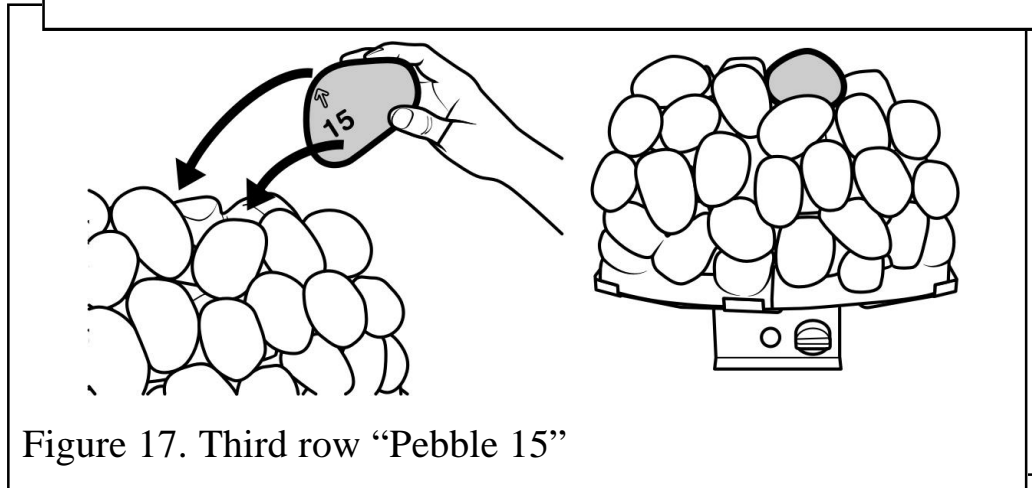


Figure 17. Third row "Pebble 15"

**15.** Hold pebble '15' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '15' as shown in figure 17.

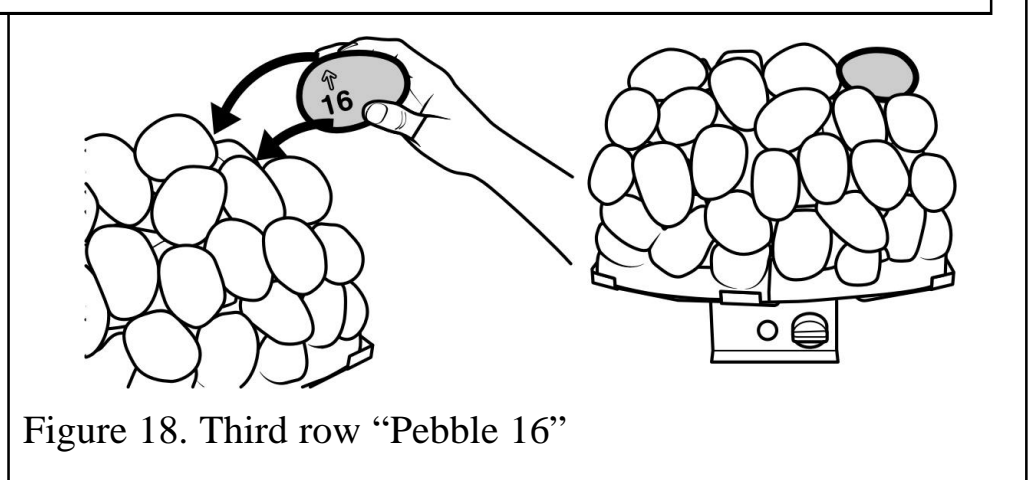


Figure 18. Third row "Pebble 16"

**16.** Hold pebble '16' upright with the arrow pointing to the top. Locate pebble '16' as shown in figure 18.
